This year's tournament will use a scramble format and will begin with a staggered start at 12:30 p.m. A buffet lunch will be available prior to the tournament. You may sign up with a friend, with three others as a foursome, or as a single.

Prizes will be awarded for lowest score, closest to the pin, longest drive and a few surprise categories.

Thanks to a generous sponsorship from **Toyota**, we are pleased to announce that Gil Morgan, a top-ranked professional on the Champions golf tour, will participate in the Tuesday, August 7th MBS golf tournament. Gil will address our tournament players at a lunch preceding the event. During the tournament, he will be stationed at one of the Par 3s on the Wolverine Course and will hit to the green with each foursome. Players who hit a better tee shot than Gil (closer to the hole) will win a prize. Participation is limited to 128 golfers on the Wolverine course. Additional slots are available on the Bear course.

You must be registered for one or more days of the conference to be eligible to play.

Last year's tournament was a sell-out, so sign up early! The cost is \$110 for lunch and golf. (If you must cancel, we will refund all but \$25.)
